

# Camping Regulations

The purpose of these regulations is to ensure the best possible service for all campers by setting the terms for the proper operation of the campsite. Respect for the regulations is essential. Entering and staying at the camping site automatically implies your acceptance of the following terms:

- All campers, both permanent and temporary, must present their passport or ID upon arrival at the campsite.
- Visitors are not allowed to enter the camping area with their cars.
- Vehicle movement is allowed only upon entry and exit, and must be at low speed (maximum 10 km/h).
- On the day of departure, campers must vacate their spot by 14:00 (2:00 PM), otherwise, an additional overnight stay will be charged.
- Sound systems are strictly prohibited throughout your stay.
- Quiet hours are from **15:00 to 17:00** and from **24:00 to 07:00**. (Police Regulation No. 3 – Government Gazette B 15 – 12.01.1996)

During quiet hours:

- The main gate barriers remain closed.
- The central gate remains closed except for the pedestrian side entrance (entrance and exit only by foot) and the entrance towards the beach.
- Perimeter gates remain closed from 24:00 to 07:00.
- The main gate opens only in emergencies.
- All forms of noise are prohibited: loud talking, music, parties, vehicle movement.
- During non-quiet hours, music and noise must be kept at low levels and must not disturb others.
- We particularly emphasize the issue of bicycle traffic during quiet hours and kindly request that bicycle circulation be avoided during these times.
- The setup or removal of camping equipment should be avoided during quiet hours. If necessary, it must be done quietly and respectfully.
- The camping site operates under tourism legislation and is supervised by the Greek National Tourism Organization (EOT). Rental agreements do not fall under civil or commercial leasing laws.
- The formation of any club or association based at the campsite, as well as the use of its name, is strictly forbidden.
- Campsite spots are assigned by reception. Changing spots without permission is strictly prohibited. The campsite management reserves the right to request a change of spot, either during summer or winter, or to move equipment in urgent cases.
- Any construction or modification of the camping area is strictly forbidden without written approval from the management (e.g. roofs, fences, storage rooms, barbecues, showers).
- Washing cars, boats, etc., within the campsite is prohibited.
- Campers may place their own umbrellas on the beach at a distance of at least 20 meters on either side of the designated area for the company's umbrellas, in order to ensure free access to the beach. It is reminded that the placement of permanent umbrellas on the beach is prohibited and, in the event of an inspection, violators are subject to the consequences of the law.
- Each spot has its own electricity supply with a maximum limit of 1500 watts. Use only safe, tested power extensions. Avoid using multi-plug adapters and unsafe connectors.
- Using neighboring unused power supplies is prohibited and will incur an extra electricity charge. Tampering with electrical supply boxes is strictly forbidden.

## **Pets**

- Pets are allowed only for visitors who have their own camping means, provided that they have a health booklet showing that the pets are fully healthy and have received the vaccinations required by law. Their owners are obliged to take all necessary measures to protect the health and safety of the campers and visitors of the Camping, according to Law 4039, Article 5 (Government Gazette 15/2-2-2012). Specifically, animals must be kept on a leash, be accompanied by their owners, and their owners must collect their waste. Pets are not allowed on the beach (Blue Flag regulation). The Management will be forced to remove pet owners who do not comply with the above terms.

## **Additional Regulations**

- It is prohibited for boats to remain on the beach in front of the camping area. The movement of boats is also prohibited within the swimming zone, as defined by the buoys placed for this purpose.
- Parents are fully responsible for ensuring that their children comply with the regulations, as well as for their supervision and care. Especially young children must always be accompanied by their guardians in the areas and shared facilities of the camping site. The stay of minor children (4-8 years old) without their parents in the surrounding areas of the reception is permitted until 23:00.
- Maintaining hygiene and cleanliness is essential and a sign of good manners and culture.
- Chemical toilet disposal must be done EXCLUSIVELY in the designated area.
- Campers are responsible for safeguarding their personal belongings. The camping management is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage.
- The Management of the Camping bears no responsibility for any damage, theft, loss, or fire caused to the tent or caravan within the Camping area during its operation period, if it results from third parties or weather phenomena (flood, lightning, fire, falling tree).
- The use of shared refrigerators is entirely at the camper's own risk.
- Campers are responsible for damages they or their visitors may cause to the camping facilities or equipment.
- Signs, badges, and announcements posted at the campsite are part of these regulations.
- The Management of the Camping is solely responsible for making decisions and has the right to remove campers or visitors whose behavior is deemed problematic for the safety of others and the smooth operation of the facility. The Management also reserves the right to impose appropriate fines for any violation.

**Entering the campsite signifies full acceptance of the above regulations.**
